

INTERNSHIP And TOEIC®

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The full-time Internship covers the areas of listening, speaking, reading, writing and grammar.

Students are expected to do homework as part of the course.

All course materials are provided and self-study facilities and a student library are also available.

The Internship is designed to give students work experience and improved language skills in a professional environment.

The placement will develop the learning of life skills such as team work, task completion, decision making, organisational skills, communication skills, confidence building etc.

This course leads to the TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication)

The students do a minimum of 1 week's tuition followed by a minimum of 4 weeks' work experience

Students can also attend a weekly language clinic, free of charge, where they will get tuition to help with any grammar, homework, etc.
