

BOURNEMOUTH WORK EXPERIENCE

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to combine part-time study with paid work experience for 12 to 52 weeks. Students work at a hotel / catering placement in or near Bournemouth.

The syllabus includes practice in listening, speaking, reading, writing and grammar.

Students are expected to do homework as part of the course.

All course materials are provided and self-study facilities and a student library are also available.

Students can take the TOEIC Test or a range of Cambridge Examinations.

Students can also attend a weekly language clinic, free of charge, where they will get tuition to help with any grammar, homework, etc.
